WHAT ARE THE TOP 10 STEPS FOR ASSESSING - THE SKIN ON THE LOWER LIMBS - CHECKLIST

A fundamental part of taking care of your lower limbs is paying attention to your skin.

It is important for individuals or their carers to inspect the skin in the lower limbs every day and make note of any changes that can be indicative of any underlying conditions or poor leg health.

Colour / Pigmentation	1) Is there any discolouration around the legs or feet? 2) Is there any reddish/brown staining above the ankles? 3) Does the skin change colour when a finger is pressed down on it? 4) How long does it take for the skin to return to its original colour after it is pressed down?
Hydration	1) Does the skin appear dry and scaly?
Texture	1) Does the skin feel rough and flaky? 2) Is the skin peeling in some parts of the lower limbs? 3) Is there a noticeable thickening of the outer layer of skin (hyperkeratosis)? 4) Does the skin feel wet, soft and wrinkled? 5) Does the skin look and feel stretched and tight?
Fragility	1) Does the skin look thin? 2) Does the skin break or rip easily, even after minimal trauma? 3) Is there increased skin tenderness?
Warmth / Coolness	1) Does any skin on the lower limbs feel warm? 2) Is the skin cold to touch?
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Infection	 1) Are there any signs of cellulitis (pain, pitted skin, redness and warmth)? 2) Are there any rashes around the lower limbs? 3) Is an existing wound producing excessive exudate? 4) Are any skin issues accompanied by fever, chills or nausea?



Broken Skin	 1) Are there any cuts, scrapes or cracks in the skin on the lower limbs? 2) Is there any ulceration around the legs?
Skin Irritation	1) Does the skin feel itchy or tender? 2) Does the skin look redder than usual? 3) Does the skin feel bumpy?
Oedema	1) Are one or both of the lower limbs swollen? 2) Is the swelling concentrated around the ankles?
Changes In The Veins	1) Are there varicose veins around the legs? 2) Has the skin around the varicose veins become dry and itchy?
